

DIRECTIONS FOR THE 2020 BEE QUILT CHALLENGE

Corrected Directions as of 12/17/2019

(Width of fabric for exchange has been corrected to 2.5" X WOF)

At the December meeting, we will pass around a sign up list for the 2020 Bee Challenge. If you will be absent and want to participate, send Jan an email or phone her at 702-684-0044. We will announce the total number of participants at the January meeting so you will know how much fabric to buy/bring.

At the February 2020 meeting, we will exchange the following:

Blue batik fabrics, a **piece 2.5" X WOF** for each participant. Blue must be the primary color, but it can contain other accent colors.

Rules for the challenge:

Make a quilt or any other sewed item measuring a maximum of 100 inches around, doesn't have to be square but total measurement no more than 100 inches adding up all four sides.

Theme should be, something related to the color blue, i.e. blue flowers, blue (sad), just anything with the theme of blue and what it means to you. You must write down your quilt title and present it with your quilt at the judging.

You can use as many other fabrics as you wish, but you must use a visible piece of each fabric received in the exchange.

Quilt must be completely finished and quilted prior to entry.

Quilts will be presented and judged in the late fall of 2020. Members will vote for ONE QUILT as the winner, and the quilt with the most votes will win, second vote getter will be second, third vote getter will be third. Prizes will be presented.
